Gail Huff has been a general assignment new reporter for WCVB-TV Channel 5 since August 1993. She currently works as NewsCenter 5's EyeOpener reporter.

Huff's broadcast journalism career began in Greenville, N.C., in 1984 where she anchored the 6 p.m. and 11 p.m. newscasts at WNCT-TV. In 1986, she joined WLNE-TV in Providence, RI., as a general assignment reporter. She assumed the same role at WFSB-TV in Hartford, Conn., in 1989. All three stations were CBS affiliates.

Huff has a diverse broadcast production and on-air background. She hosted a half-hour parenting series with child psychologist; Dr. Penelope Leach called "Your Baby & Child" on Lifetime television.

A 1980 graduate of Waltham High School, Huff received her B.S. in Business Communications from Bentley College and attended Emerson's College's graduate program in Broadcast Journalism.
